We offer a voluntary extended warranty covering manufacturing defects in our engineered wood flooring products, subject to the terms, conditions, exclusions, and registration requirements in this document.

LEGAL DETAIL

1. Warranty Period

Flooring Surgeons warrants that **Laminate Flooring** products sold under the Flooring Surgeons brand will be free from manufacturing defects for the following periods from the original date of purchase:

- Residential use: 25 years from the date of purchase
- Commercial use: 10 years from the date of purchase
- The warranty period begins on the date shown on the original purchase receipt or invoice

2. Warranty Registration

Registration Required Within 21 Days

To activate this warranty, the original purchaser must register their product within **21 days** of the purchase date. Registration can be completed:

Failure to register within the specified period may void the warranty.

3. Who Is Covered

This warranty:

- applies only to the original purchaser named on the original sales invoice
- is non-transferable
- may only be claimed by the person whose details match the original invoice and warranty registration record
- applies only to the flooring installed at the original installation address

Any claim made by a subsequent owner, tenant, occupier, assignee, or other third party will not be accepted.

4. What This Warranty Covers

This warranty covers manufacturing defects in the LVT flooring product itself only, where the product:

- has been fully paid for
- has been properly stored, handled, inspected, installed, and maintained
- has been used only for its intended purpose
- has been installed strictly in accordance with all Flooring Surgeons installation instructions, subfloor requirements, environmental requirements, adhesive requirements where applicable, and care and maintenance guidance
- remains at the original installation address
- was not installed with any visible defect that should reasonably have been identified before or during installation

For commercial use, this warranty applies only to normal commercial use within the product's intended performance limits.

EXCLUSIONS & PROCEDURES

5. What This Warranty Does Not Cover

This warranty does not cover any issue arising wholly or partly from any of the following.

A Installation and workmanship

- incorrect, poor, careless, or incomplete installation
- installation by an unqualified, negligent, or careless installer
- failure to follow Flooring Surgeons installation instructions
- failure to check, prepare, prime, smooth, level, or test the subfloor properly before installation
- installation over an unsuitable, uneven, unstable, damp, contaminated, unprepared, or incompatible subfloor
- failure to use suitable smoothing compounds, primers, adhesives, underlays, damp-proof systems, or moisture suppression systems where required
- failure to allow required expansion gaps or movement allowances for SPC Click installations
- installation beneath or under fixed units, kitchen islands, heavy cabinetry, or other fixed loads where not permitted by the installation guidance
- any workmanship issue, fitting fault, poor setting out, peaking, tenting, gapping, lifting, bond failure, telegraphing, or movement caused by installation error rather than a manufacturing defect in the product itself

B Inspection, Visible Defects, and Product Acceptance

- any visible defect, shade variation, size variation, surface issue, finish issue, grade issue, or machining issue that was visible before installation
- any product installed after a defect should reasonably have been noticed
- any complaint relating to colour, shade, grain, texture, knots, mineral streaks, sap, filler, character marks, colour variation, natural figuring, brushing, saw marks, bevel detail, or finish where the product was installed despite the issue being visible at the time
- the natural characteristics of timber, including variation in grain, shade, texture, knots, figuring, medullary rays, mineral marks, sapwood, filler, and other natural features
- minor dimensional tolerances, batch variation, colour variation, grade variation, or manufacturing variation within normal and acceptable industry tolerances

C Moisture, Water, Subfloor, and Environmental Conditions

- water ingress, flooding, leaks, standing water, plumbing failure, appliance leaks, damp, condensation, or any other form of moisture exposure
- excessive moisture in the subfloor, surrounding structure, or environment
- failure to carry out proper moisture testing before installation
- failure to maintain suitable site temperature, humidity, and environmental conditions before, during, and after installation
- movement of the wood caused by moisture imbalance, dry conditions, excessive heat, humidity fluctuation, or unsuitable site conditions
- swelling, expansion, contraction, warping, cupping, crowning, bowing, checking, splitting, cracking, joint movement, end separation, or delamination caused by site conditions, moisture imbalance, or environmental change rather than a proven manufacturing defect
- installation in wet rooms, bathrooms, saunas, steam rooms, external areas, or other high-moisture environments unless expressly approved in writing by Flooring Surgeons
- damage caused by underfloor heating systems not approved by Flooring Surgeons, or not operated strictly in accordance with the relevant installation guidance
- D. Acclimatisation and Underfloor Heating

EXCLUSIONS & PROCEDURES

D Acclimatisation and Underfloor Heating

- failure to properly acclimatise the flooring before installation
- installation before the site conditions were suitable and stable
- installation over underfloor heating systems that are unsuitable for engineered wood flooring
- failure to commission, test, switch off, restart, or operate underfloor heating strictly in accordance with Flooring Surgeons guidance
- excessive surface temperature, rapid temperature changes, or heat concentration caused by rugs, mats, furniture, or other coverings over heated floors
- damage caused by underfloor heating used outside the permitted temperature or operating conditions

E Wear, Damage, Use, and Maintenance

- normal wear and tear
- scratches, scuffs, dents, chips, marks, burns, cuts, stains, indentations, or impact damage
- damage caused by pets, claws, grit, stones, dirt, footwear, stilettos, furniture, castors, wheeled traffic, dropped items, or heavy loads
- abuse, misuse, neglect, improper handling, or improper storage
- use of unsuitable cleaning products, steam cleaners, abrasive cleaners, excessive water, harsh chemicals, waxes, oils, or maintenance products not suitable for the specific finish
- inadequate, incorrect, or inconsistent maintenance
- reduction in surface appearance, gloss change, surface dulling, or natural ageing over time
- fading, discolouration, shading variation, oxidation, darkening, mellowing, yellowing, or other colour change caused by sunlight, UV exposure, normal ageing, or partial coverage of the floor by rugs, mats, furniture, or other items
- colour variation between exposed and covered areas of flooring, including where flooring has been covered for prolonged periods, as this is a natural effect of ageing and light exposure and is not a manufacturing defect

F Commercial Use and Use Limitations

- use outside the product's intended wear rating or performance category
- heavy commercial, industrial, workshop, gym, healthcare, hospitality, entranceway, or other high-stress applications unless expressly agreed in writing by Flooring Surgeons before purchase
- damage caused by rolling loads, excessive point loading, machinery, pallet trucks, or abnormal traffic conditions

G Other Exclusions

- defects or damage caused by accidents, alterations, sanding, refinishing, third-party works, structural movement, subsidence, force majeure, or events beyond the reasonable control of Flooring Surgeons
- dissatisfaction with the product where there is no actual manufacturing defect
- any issue arising from a failure to comply with this warranty or associated installation and maintenance instructions

EXCLUSIONS & PROCEDURES

6. Conditions of Warranty

This warranty is valid only if:

- the flooring was inspected before installation
- no planks or tiles with visible defects were installed
- the flooring was installed in accordance with all applicable guidance issued by Flooring Surgeons
- the flooring has been used only in a suitable environment and for its intended purpose
- the original purchaser retains the original sales invoice and proof of registration
- any claim is made by the original purchaser only
- the flooring remains at the original installation address

7. Claims Procedure

To make a claim under this voluntary extended warranty, the purchaser must:

- notify Flooring Surgeons in writing within 14 days of discovering the alleged defect
- stop installation immediately if the alleged defect is discovered before installation is complete
- refrain from carrying out uplift, replacement, repair, or other remedial work before Flooring Surgeons has had a reasonable opportunity to inspect the product and installation
- provide the original sales invoice
- provide proof of warranty registration
- provide photographs, batch details, room details, and any other information reasonably requested
- allow Flooring Surgeons or its nominated representative reasonable access to inspect the product, subfloor, and installation

8. Remedy

If a valid claim is accepted, Flooring Surgeons may, at its sole discretion:

- repair the affected product, or
- replace the affected product, or
- supply the nearest equivalent product if the original product has been discontinued, or
- refund the price paid for the affected product only

Any repair, replacement, alternative product, or refund shall be limited strictly to the affected flooring product only. Any replacement product supplied under this warranty does not restart or extend the original warranty period. The warranty will continue only for the remainder of the original term.

EXCLUSIONS & PROCEDURES

9. Exclusion of Other Costs and Losses

This warranty applies to the flooring product only.

For the avoidance of doubt, this warranty does not cover any fitting, labour, uplift, disposal, preparation, subfloor works, smoothing compounds, primers, adhesives, underlays, trims, accessories, delivery, storage, inspection, accommodation, travel, delay, inconvenience, loss of use, third-party contractor charges, or any other associated costs or losses.

This warranty does not cover:

- installation or reinstallation costs
- uplift or removal costs
- subfloor preparation, levelling, smoothing, moisture suppression, or rectification costs
- adhesives, primers, underlays, trims, profiles, accessories, or ancillary materials
- storage, delivery, accommodation, travel, delay, inconvenience, or loss of use
- third-party labour charges, contractor costs, or inspection fees
- any indirect, incidental, special, or consequential loss

10. General

This warranty is a voluntary extended warranty offered by Flooring Surgeons.

This warranty is provided in addition to, and does not replace or restrict, any rights the purchaser may have under applicable consumer law.

No retailer, installer, agent, representative, or third party has authority to vary, extend, or waive any part of this warranty unless confirmed in writing by Flooring Surgeons.

Flooring Surgeons reserves the right to inspect all alleged defects and all relevant installation conditions before accepting any liability under this warranty.
